SENATE AMENDMENT "Q" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 343, L.D. 468, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2006 and June 30, 2007"

Amend the amendment by adding after Part PPPP the following:

PART QQQQ

Sec. QQQQ-1. 20-A MRSA §15689, sub-§1, ¶B, as repealed and replaced by PL 2005, c. 2, Pt. D, §58 and affected by §§72 and 73, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

B. The school administrative unit's special education costs as calculated pursuant to section 15681-A, subsection 2 multiplied by 84%.

Sec. QQQQ-2. Effective date. This Part takes effect July 1, 2005.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
