2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1051, sub-§3, ¶C is enacted to read:**

6 C. For purposes of this subsection, the licensed premises
8 of a golf club may include, at the discretion of the
10 licensee, the buildings and grounds but not the parking lot.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill permits the buildings and grounds but not the
parking lot of a golf club to be included in the licensed
premises for purposes of on-premises liquor licenses.
