18	This bill increases the fee paid to a municipality for
	providing a copy of a birth, marriage or death certificate from
20	\$7 to \$10 for the first copy and from \$3 to \$5 for each additional copy. The bill also increases the burial permit fee
22	from \$4 to \$5. The fees currently paid to the State for providing a copy of a birth, marriage or death certificate is \$15

for the first copy and \$6 for each additional copy.
