6 Sec. 3. Legislation. Resolved: That the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over inland fisheries and 8 wildlife matters may submit legislation to the First Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature to implement any recommendation 10 presented in the report under section 2.'

#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve and directs the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to work with tribal members to determine the feasibility of providing moose hunting permits for use on nontribal lands. The resolve directs the department to report its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over inland fisheries and wildlife matters by January 17, 2007 and authorizes the committee to report out legislation to the First Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.
