Capping the tuition amount that a sending school unit would pay to the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund to send students to a school maintained by the State in the unorganized territory at the prior year's state average expenditure per elementary pupil will decrease tuition costs for the sending school unit and increase costs to residents in the Unorganized Territory.
