4.0	This amendment reduces from 6 months to 30 days the proposed
42	delay during which nonemergency rules adopted by the Department of Health and Human Services pertaining to process or procedural
44	changes for licensed health care providers do not take effect
46	after adoption. The amendment also clarifies that the 30-day period applies only to rules affecting process or procedural changes for those providers and that the 30-day period does not
