Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:
.C. 4 21 A MDCA 9772 1 91
'Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §553, sub-§1, as enacted by IB 1993, c. 1, §1 and affected by §2, is amended to read:
1. State Senate. A person may not serve more than -4- 6 consecutive terms as a state Senator, except that a person
elected to serve a term in the 122nd Legislature may not serve
more than 4 consecutive terms as a state Senator.
Sec. 2. 21-A MRSA §553, sub-§2, as enacted by IB 1993, c. 1.
§1 and affected by §2, is amended to read:
2. State Representative. A person may not serve more than
4- <u>6</u> consecutive terms as a member of the state House of Representatives, except that a person elected to serve a term in
the 122nd Legislature may not serve more than 4 consecutive terms
as a state Representative.'

inserting in its place the following:

12	Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

16	SUMMARY
18	This amendment clarifies that the 8-year term limits apply to anyone serving in the 122nd Legislature. Persons who are
20	elected for the first time or to a nonconsecutive term in the 123rd Legislature will have term limits of 12 years.

24	The amendment also changes the referendum to make it coincide with the next general election in November.
