COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 376, L.D. 501, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Operator's License and Nondriver Identification Card Requirements for Nonimmigrants"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Amend the Operator's License and Nondriver Identification Card Requirements'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1301, sub-§10 is enacted to read:

10. Expired documents. The Secretary of State may not accept the following documents as identification for the purpose of issuing a nondriver identification card or driver's license:

A. An expired visa granted by the authority of the United States;

B. An expired document issued by a foreign country; or

C. A foreign passport showing an elapsed departure date.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 376, L.D. 501

2 Committee on Transportation. It replaces the bill and prohibits
the acceptance of expired visas granted by the United States,
4 expired documents issued by foreign countries and foreign
passports showing an elapsed departure date as identification for
6 the purpose of issuing state nondriver identification cards and
driver's licenses.
