Initiative: Allocates funds for one additional Motor Vehicle Service Representative position, one additional Clerk Typist III position and one additional Motor Vehicle Investigator position necessary to administer new identification requirements for the issuance of driver's licenses and nondriver identification cards.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Changes to driver licensure and identification requirements will necessitate an additional Highway Fund allocation of \$162,680 in fiscal year 2006-07 to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles within the Department of the Secretary of State for 3 additional positions, operating expenses and the reprogramming of computer systems. In addition, the restructuring of certain licensure fees will result in the loss of Highway Fund revenue of \$17,250 in fiscal year 2006-07.
