'1. Board of directors. The authority consists of a board
of 7 directors. The 7 directors are the Commissioner of
Transportation, who is a director ex officio, the Commissioner of
Economic and Community Development, who also is a director ex
officio, and 5 directors who are members of the public, appointed
by the Governor and confirmed by the joint standing committee of
the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters
for 5-year staggered terms, who shall serve until their
respective successors are appointed and qualified. A vacancy in
a position held by a director who is a member of the public
occurring other than by the expiration of a term must be filled
by the Governor and confirmed by the joint standing committee of
the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters
for the unexpired term.'

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Further amend the bill by inserting after section 9 the following:

'Sec. 10 Transition provision. Current appointed members of the Northern New England Passenger Rail Authority board of directors shall serve until their terms expire.

Sec. 11. Extension of passenger rail service. The Department of Transportation shall develop a plan to extend the existing passenger rail service between Boston, Massachusetts and Portland northward to Brunswick and Rockland so that this extended service is in operation no later than January 1, 2008. The Department of Transportation shall submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation with its findings and recommendations no later than January 1, 2006.

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Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

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## 38 SUMMARY

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill. It requires members of the board of directors of the Northern New England Passenger Rail Authority who are appointed by the Governor to be confirmed by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over amendment also transportation matters. The directs Department of Transportation to develop a plan to extend the current Downeaster passenger rail service northward from Portland to Brunswick and Rockland so that this extended service is in operation no later than January 1, 2008. It directs the Department of Transportation to submit a report with its findings

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and recommendations to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation no later than January 1, 2006. The amendment also adds a transition provision section.
