An Act Concerning Dismantling of Railroad Track

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §7107, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 498, §4, is amended to read:

- 6 §7107. Dismantling of state-owned track

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8 Except as provided in this section, the Department of Transportation, a county or municipality or other political subdivision of this State, a public agency or commission, a 10 public service corporation or district or a private entity may not dismantle or contract with a-state agency - or - private - entity 12 anyone for the dismantling of state-ewned track. When the 14 department owner of the track, in consultation with a regional economic planning entity and a regional transportation advisory committee established in accordance with rules adopted under 16 section 73, subsection 4, determines that removal of a specific 18 length of rail ewned-by-the-State will not have a negative impact on a region or on future economic opportunities for that region, the Commissioner-of-Transportation owner of the track shall seek 20 review by and approval of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters prior 22 to removal. 24

SUMMARY

28 This bill amends the law establishing procedures for dismantling railroad track so that it applies to any track, not 30 just state-owned track.
