2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §18252, sub-§5**, as amended by PL 2003, c. 630,  
Pt. A, §4, is further amended to read:

6 **5. Limit on right to rejoin.** The right of a person to  
rejoin under subsection 3 is limited to ~~one--occurrence~~ 2  
8 occurrences.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill increases the limit on the right to rejoin the  
14 Maine State Retirement System from one occurrence to 2  
occurrences.
