Limit on right to rejoin. The right of a person to rejoin under subsection 3 is limited to one--occurrence 2 8 occurrences. 10 SUMMARY 12 This bill increases the limit on the right to rejoin the Maine State Retirement System from one occurrence to 2 14 occurrences.
