## An Act To Ban the Use of Handheld Cellular Telephones while Operating a Motor Vehicle

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2116 is enacted to read:

6	§2116. Use of handheld cellular telephone while operating motor vehicle
8	1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the
10	<u>context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.</u>
12	<u>A. "Cellular telephone" means a device used to access wireless telephone service.</u>
14	B. "Handheld cellular telephone" means a cellular telephone
16	with which a user engages in a call using at least one hand.
18	C, "Hands-free cellular telephone" means a cellular telephone that has an internal feature or function, or that
20	is equipped with an attachment or addition, whether or not permanently part of the cellular telephone, by which a user
22	may activate and deactivate the phone and talk and listen without the use of either hand.
24	2. Prohibition. A person may not operate a motor vehicle
26	while using a handheld cellular telephone. A person may not operate a motor vehicle while using a hands-free cellular
28	telephone unless the features of the cellular telephone that allow hands-free operation are being used.
30	3. Penalty. The following penalties apply to violations of
32	this section.
34 36	A. A person who violates this section commits a traffic infraction for which a fine of not less than \$50 may be adjudged.
38	B. A person who violates this section after being adjudicated as violating this section commits a traffic
40	<u>infraction for which a fine of not less than \$250 may be</u> adjudged.
42	4. Exception. This section does not apply to the following
44	persons operating a motor vehicle within the scope of their employment:

10	SUMMARY
12	This bill prohibits the use of a handheld cellular telephone
	while operating a motor vehicle. The bill clarifies that law
14	enforcement officers, corrections officers, firefighters, drivers

16	licenses, physicians, municipal public works personnel, Maine
	Turnpike Authority personnel and state transportation personnel,

	offense a traffic infraction.
