2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6175** is enacted to read:

6 **§6175. Alternative bait**

8 The commissioner may adopt rules to regulate the use of
10 alternative bait in marine fisheries. Rules authorized by this
12 section must be adopted in accordance with the procedures in
14 subchapter 2 and are routine technical rules as defined in Title
16 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill authorizes the Commissioner of Marine Resources to regulate the use of alternative bait in marine fisheries.
