	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6701-A is enacted to read:

	<u>§6701-A. Scallop spat license</u>

•	1. License required. A person may not engage in the
8	activities authorized under this section without a current
10	scallop spat license or other license issued under this Part authorizing the activities.

12	2. Licensed activities. The holder of a scallop spat
	license may harvest, possess, ship, transport or sell scallop
14	spat. Notwithstanding section 6721-A, a person who holds a valid
	scallop spat license may possess, ship or transport undersize
16	scallops raised from scallop spat harvested pursuant to this
	<u>permit.</u>

	3. Fee. The fee for a scallop spat license is \$111.

	4. Violation. A person who violates this section commits
22	a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$100
24	<u>nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.</u>

28	This bill creates a scallop spat harvesting license that
	allows the licensee to harvest, possess, ship, transport or sell
30	scallop spat. The bill also permits a licensee to possess
	undersize scallops raised from scallop spat harvested pursuant to
32	a scallop spat license.
