HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 180, L.D. 572, Bill, "An Act To Eliminate Term Limits in the Legislature"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first paragraph after the title and all of section 1 (page 1, lines 22 to 40 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:'

Further amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the question (page 2, lines 7 and 8 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'"Do you favor repealing term limits for Legislators?"'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the language added by Committee Amendment "A" that applied the repeal of term limits only to Legislators who serve their first nonconsecutive terms beginning December 3, 2006.
