The eity <u>City</u> of Portland are <u>is</u> hereby authorized to appropriate and pay, annually, toward the expenses of establishing and maintaining said institution, -- a---sum--net exceeding-one-dollar-for-each-of-its-ratable-polls, --in-the-year next-preceding-that-in-which-said-appropriation-is-made; and may also furnish rooms for its accommodation.
