HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 422, L.D. 589, "An Act To Strengthen Ethical Standards Regarding Former Legislators"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 2 and 3 (page 1, lines 41 to 52 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

**Sec. 2. Report and recommendations. Resolved:** That the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices shall report its findings and recommendations, including suggested legislation if appropriate, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters no later than January 15, 2007; and be it further


**Sec. 3. Authority to report out legislation. Resolved:** That the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters is authorized to report out legislation concerning the study undertaken pursuant to section 1 to the First Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the date by which the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices must submit its report from January 15, 2006 to January 15, 2007 and also changes the
