	Sec.1. 20-A MRSA §3301, sub-§8 is enacted to read:

	8. Closing school. The commissioner may not close a school
6	in the unorganized territory except in accordance with procedures
	and standards established by the department by rule. The rules
8	must provide for a public hearing in the area served by a school
	prior to the date of the proposed closure of the school. Rules
10	adopted pursuant to this subsection are major substantive rules
	<u>as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.</u>

16	This bill requires the Department of Education to adopt
	major substantive rules to establish standards and practices to
18	follow when proposing to close a school in the unorganized
	territory.
