Sec. 1. Local alternatives to mail-order pharmacy for MaineCare beneficiaries. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services shall provide to all MaineCare beneficiaries a local alternative to out-of-state mail-order pharmacies for access to medications; and be it further

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Sec. 2. Savings; legislative intent. Resolved: That it is the intent of the Legislature that any savings in the form of reduced hospitalizations realized as a result of implementing a local pharmacy access option must be divided equally among providers, pharmacies and the MaineCare program.
