Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §8005, sub-§3 is enacted to read:
3. Extending passenger rail service to midcoast Maine
Beginning in January 2006, the authority shall seek and use fund
necessary to extend regularly scheduled passenger rail service
from Portland to Rockland and points in between.
SUMMARY
This bill directs the Northern New England Passenger Rai
Authority to extend regularly scheduled passenger rail service
between Portland and Rockland and points in between beginning January 2006.
