This bill assists municipalities in implementing and
enforcing storm water management programs to regulate and control
torm water pollution. The bill ensures that the District Court
and Superior Court have concurrent jurisdiction to hear
enforcement actions brought by municipalities regarding
violations of ordinances and ordinance provisions they are
equired to enact, implement and enforce regarding nonstorm water
lischarges, construction site runoff and postconstruction storm
rater management. The bill also adds these ordinances to the
ist of environmental ordinances that the municipality may
nforce using the land use enforcement mechanism, pursuant to the
Taine Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 80K, authorizing code
nforcement officers to prosecute certain violations and by which
prevailing municipality may obtain a fine, injunctive relief or
ayment of attorney's fees, expert witness fees and costs from
he violator if the municipality prevails.
