Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$14,000 in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$7,000 in fiscal year 2006-07 to the University of Maine System for the costs associated with training and increased staff hours at the information and circulation desks to ensure compliance with this legislation.

Additional costs to the Maine State Library, the Law and Legislative Reference Library and the Maine Maritime Academy associated with providing existing information to parents or legal guardians of a minor upon written request can be absorbed utilizing existing budgeted resources.
