An Act To Promote Parental Responsibility When Minors Make Use of Public Libraries

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 27 MRSA §121, as amended by PL 1997, c. 146, §1 and 4 affected by §2, is further amended to read:

6 §121. Confidentiality of library records

8 Records maintained by any public municipal library, the Maine State Library, the Law and Legislative Reference Library 10 and libraries of the University of Maine System and the Maine Maritime Academy that contain information relating to the identity of a library patron relative to the patron's use of 12 books or other materials at the library are confidential. Those records may only be released with the express written permission 14 of the patron involved or as the result of a court order. In the 16 case of the use of books or other materials by a minor, the library records must be released upon the written request of the 18 minor's parent or guardian.

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SUMMARY

This bill requires public municipal and state libraries to 24 release confidential records concerning a minor's use of books or other materials in the library upon the written request of a 26 parent or guardian of the minor.
