Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 19-A MRSA §953, sub-§6-A is enacted to read: 4 6-A. Nonowner spouse interest in certain payments or accounts. After the filing of a divorce complaint under section 6 901, a nonowner spouse has an inchoate equitable ownership interest in the individual retirement account or similar plan or 8 contract on account of illness, disability, death, age or length 10 of service of the spouse. 12 14

SUMMARY

16 This bill adds to the marital property statutes for divorce an inchoate equitable interest for a nonowner spouse in certain property, such as an individual retirement account, once a 18 divorce complaint has been filed.
