**Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11402, sub-§4, ¶C**, as enacted by PL 2003, c.  
4 414, Pt. A, §2 and affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:

C. Establish a youth deer hunting day. If the commissioner

allow a youth who takes a deer on that day to take another
