COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 481, L.D. 661, Bill, "An Act To Allow Dental Hygienists To Perform Temporary Filling Procedures"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1098-E.~~" by striking out all of the indented paragraph (page 1, lines 7 to 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'A dental hygienist with public health supervision status, as defined by rules adopted by the Board of Dental Examiners, may perform temporary filling procedures without a dentist present under protocols developed by the Board of Dental Examiners. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that dental hygienists with public health supervision status, as defined by rules adopted by the Board of Dental Examiners, may perform temporary filling procedures without a dentist present under protocols developed by the Board of Dental Examiners.
