2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1098-E** is enacted to read:

6 **§1098-E. Temporary filling procedures**

8 A dental hygienist may perform a temporary filling procedure
10 without a dentist present if a follow-up appointment with a
12 dentist licensed in the State has been scheduled for the patient.

14 **SUMMARY**

This bill allows a dental hygienist to perform a temporary filling procedure without a dentist present.
