Sec. 1. Access to geographic information system data. Resolved:

2 That the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency
Management, Maine Emergency Management Agency shall develop
4 reasonable restrictions on who may access state geographic
information system data. The Maine Emergency Management Agency
6 shall develop policies and procedures to establish and collect
identifying information from anyone wishing to access such data,
8 including but not limited to personal identification, address and
the purpose for which the data is being requested. The Maine
10 Emergency Management Agency may adopt routine technical rules
pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375,
12 subchapter 2-A to implement this section.

18 This resolve directs the Maine Emergency Management Agency
to develop reasonable restrictions on who may access state
geographic information system data. It also requires the Maine
20 Emergency Management Agency to establish and collect identifying
information from anyone wishing to access such data, including
