18	SUMMARY

22	This bill eliminates the University of Maine System Scholarship Fund currently held by the Finance Authority of Maine and creates an identical fund to be administered by the Board of
24	Trustees of the University of Maine System. The bill also requires the Finance Authority of Maine to transfer the funds
26	from the old fund to the new fund by July 1, 2005.
