COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 233, L.D. 696, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Requirements for Publishing Municipal Legal Notices"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§3013." in subsection 4 in the last line (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§3013." in subsection 5 in the last line (page 1, line 33 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "newspaper." and inserting in its place the following: 'newspaper; and'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§3013." by inserting after subsection 5 the following:

'6. Tracking. The municipality reports that it publishes municipal legal notices in the alternative newspaper medium rather than in a newspaper of general circulation and the frequency of that publishing to the Executive Department, State Planning Office.'

This section is repealed October 15, 2007.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report. The amendment requires a municipality that publishes its municipal legal
