COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 499, L.D. 704, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Governing De Minimis Infractions of the Maine Criminal Code"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "or" the following: ', in the trial of a Class D or Class E crime,'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. This amendment limits the jury's power to consider whether the defendant's conduct represents a de minimis infraction to trials of Class D and Class E crimes.
