### An Act To Improve Care for Adults with Mental Retardation

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

#### Sec. 1. 34-B MRSA §5438 is enacted to read:

#### §5438. Residential services

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In providing residential services to a person with mental 8 retardation, whether directly or by contractual or other agreement, the department shall give preference to residential 10services provided in private homes over residential services provided in privately operated or agency-operated residential care facilities. The department shall undertake an initiative to 12 provide information to the public regarding opportunities for 14 providing residential services for persons with mental retardation, including training on mental retardation and the 16 requirements for obtaining approval as a private home provider of residential services.

#### SUMMARY

22 This bill directs the Department of Health and Human Services to give preference to residential services provided in private homes over residential services provided in privately 24 operated or agency-operated residential care facilities. Ιt directs the department to undertake an initiative to provide 26 information to the public regarding opportunities for providing residential services for persons with mental retardation, 28 including training on mental retardation and the requirements for obtaining approval as a private home provider of residential 30 services.
