## An Act To Require the Disclosure of Certain Financial Information from Hospitals and Their Affiliates

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1819-A is enacted to read:
+ 6	§1819-A. Financial disclosure
8 10	1. Disclosure required. The department shall require that a hospital licensed under this chapter annually publicly disclose, with regard to the hospital and any entity that is, in whole or in part, owned, controlled or affiliated with the beauital:

14 16	A. Federal Internal Revenue Service Form 990, including all schedules, for each entity, including the hospital, that is required to complete that form, on or before April 15th of each year or such later date that the hospital or other
18	entity files that form pursuant to duly allowed Internal Revenue Service extensions; and
20	B. For each entity not included under paragraph A, the entity's name, the address and phone number of the corporate
22	headquarters and principal Maine office and a list of the entity's officers, directors, trustees, 5 highest-paid
24	employees and 5 highest-paid independent contractors and, for each such person, that person's name, address and title,
26	average hours per week devoted to that position, compensation, benefit plans and deferred compensation,
28	including stock options, and expense account and other allowances, on or before April 15th of each year or such
30	later date that the entity files its annual tax return pursuant to duly allowed federal Internal Revenue Service
32	extensions.
34	2. Public inspection and copying. The department shall make copies of all documents disclosed pursuant to this section
36	available for public inspection and copying, and it shall post copies of those documents on the department's publicly accessible
38	site on the Internet.
40	SUMMARY
42	This bill requires a hospital licensed by the Department of
44	Health and Human Services to disclose annually certain financial information regarding the hospital and any entity that is owned,
46	controlled or affiliated with the hospital.
