Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a combination of
vehicles consisting of a pickup truck as defined in section 101,
subsection 55 and a semitrailer with a registered weight of 2,000
pounds or less may be registered under this section for the
combined gross weight of the pickup truck and the semitrailer.

Sec. 5. 29-A MRSA §504, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1999, c. 580, 24 §2 and affected by §14 and amended by c. 790, Pt. C, §8 and affected by §19, is further amended by amending the first 26 paragraph to read:

 1. Truck or truck tractor. For a <u>light truck</u>, truck or truck tractor <u>used for commercial purposes</u> equipped with
 pneumatic tires, the following annual registration fee schedule applies.

SUMMARY

36 This bill clarifies that seasonal nonresident visitors to Maine who are domiciled in this State for less than 179 days are not required to register their vehicles in this State. The bill also removes the requirement that noncommercial trucks in excess 40 of 6,000 pounds be registered as commercial vehicles.
