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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT 'A' to S.P. 239, L.D. 741

SUMMARY

This replaces the amendment requirement that the Commissioner of Health and Human Services appoint a permanent 4 brain injury advisory council with a requirement that the commissioner provide recommendations to the Joint Standing 6 Committee on Health and Human Services by January 16, 2006 on the most appropriate method for creating a permanent, effective and 8 coordinated system within the Department of Health and Human 10 Services for advising the commissioner and the department on all matters pertaining to the administration and provision of services and programs for persons with acquired brain injury and 12 their families.
