HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 246, L.D. 748, Bill, "An Act Requiring Equal Retirement Benefits for Corrections Officers and Mental Health Workers with 25 Years of State Service"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 34 in amendment) by striking out the following: "30" and inserting in its place the following: '15'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 39 and 40 in amendment) by striking out the following: "July 15" and inserting in its place the following: 'September 1'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the emergency clause.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and the emergency clause and changes the deadline for the first meeting of the Commission To Study Eliminating the Normal Retirement Age for Corrections Officers and Mental Health Workers from July 15 to September 1, 2006.
