HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 535, L.D. 758

SUMMARY

This amendment ties the percentage paid by the State for 4 retired teachers' health insurance to the percentage paid by the 5 State for state employees who retire with 10 or more years of 6 creditable service. Currently, the share paid by the State for 7 retired state employees with 10 or more years of creditable 8 service is 100%. This limitation takes effect only if the share 7 paid by the State for retired state employees is decreased to a 10 share that is less than the share paid by the State for retired 8 teachers' health insurance.

This amendment also changes the annual start date for 14 subsequent increases in the percentage paid by the State to October 1st, which results in a reduced cost in fiscal year 16 2006-07.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$335,303 in fiscal year 2006-07.

As amended, this bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$3,273,620 in fiscal year 2006-07 to increase the State's contribution of funding health insurance for retired teachers from 45% to 50% beginning October 1, 2006. As amended, this bill continues to increase the State's contribution to funding health insurance for retired teachers by 5% per year until the State's share equals 100% in fiscal year 2016-17.
