Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11401, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 2003, c.
4 414, Pt. A, §2 and affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:

6 A. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection and
sections 10952, 11152, 11403 and 11404 or by rule adopted by
8 the commissioner pursuant to section 11402, subsection 4,
there is an open season for deer in each calendar year in
10 all counties of the State ~~between--September--15th--and
December--15th--annually---~~In a year that the regular season
12 extends beyond November 30th, the regular season must start
no later than from the 4th Monday preceding Thanksgiving to
14 the 2nd Saturday following Thanksgiving.
