2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11154, sub-§13** is enacted to read:

6 13. Persons 75 years of age or older. Notwithstanding the  
8 other provisions of this section, the commissioner may issue a  
10 moose permit to an eligible person who is 75 years of age or  
12 older who has held a hunting permit issued under this chapter for  
14 3 of the previous 5 years. A permit issued under this subsection  
16 is not transferable and does not affect the number of permits  
18 that may be issued by the commissioner under this section.

#### 14 SUMMARY

16 This bill allows a person 75 years of age or older who has  
18 held a hunting permit for 3 of the past 5 years to receive a  
moose permit upon application to the Commissioner of Inland  
Fisheries and Wildlife.
