COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 540, L.D. 763

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. This amendment replaces the bill and requires the Secretary of State to collect, store and verify the social security numbers of all applicants for driver's licenses or nondriver identification cards. The amendment also prohibits the Secretary of State from issuing a driver's license or nondriver identification card to a person who does not have a valid social security number unless the person provides written proof to the Secretary of State that the person is ineligible to receive a social security number.
