Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'Resolve, To Examine Smoking Cessation Programs for Maine's Youth'**

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 3 and 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "seek to prevent young people from using tobacco products and that"

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "December 1, 2005" and inserting in its place the following: 'January 31, 2006'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the 5th, 6th and 7th lines (page 1, lines 13 to 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and may include proposed rules and legislation to change existing programs or establish new programs"
