SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 258, L.D. 791, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Taxation of Buildings in Which Nonprofit Organizations Are Housed"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the substitute title the following:


'Further amend the bill by inserting after the title the following:

'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, 2/3 of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.' '

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2.

Administrative costs associated with a property tax exemption for certain veterans' organizations. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the Constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment adds a mandate preamble and eliminates the General Fund appropriation of \$318,750 in fiscal year 2006-07 which is no longer necessary because of a later effective date. As amended, the bill still has a cost of \$334,688 in fiscal year 2007-08 and \$351,422 in fiscal year 2008-09.
