Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §1819, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 678, §13, is
4 amended by adding after the 3rd paragraph a new paragraph to read:

6 A park pass issued by the bureau may be used to gain
8 admission to Scarborough Beach State Park.
