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Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6523, as amended by PL 2001, c. 272, §8, is further amended to read:

#### §6523. Marking ice fishing shacks

A person may not place any shack or temporary structure used for ice fishing on the frozen territorial waters or use the shack or structure, unless the owner's name and address are painted or otherwise clearly marked with reflective material on the outside with 2-inch letters. A person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$100 and not more than \$500 may be adjudged.

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### 18 SUMMARY

This bill requires that the information displayed on an ice fishing shack must be in reflective material.
