Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13155, sub-§1-A, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2003, c.
4 655, Pt. B, §406 and affected by §422, is amended to read:

B. The following penalties apply to violations of this
subsection.

8

(1) A person who violates this subsection commits a
10 civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$100
\$200 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.

(2) A person who violates this subsection after having
14 been adjudicated as having committed 3 or more civil
violations under this Part within the previous 5-year
16 period commits a Class E crime.
