34	This amendment makes 2 clarifications to the bill.
36	This amendment provides that a person may not further disseminate a record or information that the person receives from
38	the Department of Health and Human Services, unless that dissemination is otherwise allowed by law. The bill prohibited
40	the dissemination of a record unless otherwise required by law.

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
