### An Act To Give 2 Moose Hunting Permits to Hunt of a Lifetime

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11154, sub-§13** is enacted to read:

6 13. Hunting adventure permits for children. The  
8 commissioner shall issue 2 moose permits to a nonprofit  
10 organization dedicated to providing hunting and fishing  
12 adventures to children under 21 years of age with  
14 life-threatening, critical or terminal illnesses. These permits  
16 are in addition to the moose hunting permits issued under  
18 subsection 2 for each wildlife management district and are at no  
20 cost to the organization.

### SUMMARY

22 This bill directs the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and  
24 Wildlife to issue 2 moose hunting permits to a nonprofit group,  
26 such as Hunt of a Lifetime, dedicated to providing hunting and  
28 fishing experiences to children under 21 years of age with  
30 life-threatening, critical or terminal illnesses.
