SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety. The amendment removes from the current reciprocity law the restriction that the Chief of the State Police may enter into reciprocity agreements with only 2 other states and allows the Chief of the State Police to enter into reciprocity agreements with an unlimited number of states if those states meet all other statutory criteria for reciprocity.
